#### Terms and Conditions

- Mail bids are encouraged and will be accepted on or before Friday, March 31. A bid form has been included for your convenience.
- E-mail bids will be accepted on or before 5pm CST on Friday, March 31. Please direct your e-mail bids to: cheeka@execpc.com
- Telephone bids will be taken on the closing days only...on Fridays, March 31 from 6pm to 2am CST for lots #1-100, and Saturday, April 1 from 6pm to 2am for lots #101-201. To place a telephone bid, please call (414) 321-6004. If the lines are busy, please keep trying. Normally, the phone lines are busiest from midnight to 2am, so call early to avoid the rush.
- The auction will end at exactly 2am on each night. If you call and get the answering machine, the auction is over for that night.
- All items have a minimum bid (MB).
- When placing a bid, please indicate your bidder number and the lot or item number. If at all possible, please bid on items in numerical order.
- The bidding increments will be as follows:

\$1-19: \$1 increment (example: current bid is at \$16. Next bid is \$17)

\$20-48: \$2 increment (example: current bid is at \$44. Next bid is \$46)

\$50-95: \$5 increment (example: current bid is at \$60. Next bid is \$65)

\$100-190: \$10 increment (example: current bid is at \$160. Next bid is \$170)

\$200-480: \$20 increment (example: current bid is at \$440. Next bid is \$460)

\$500-950: \$50 increment (example: current bid is at \$600. Next bid is at \$650)

\$1000 and over: \$100 increment (example: current bid is at \$1600. Next bid is \$1700)

- I can execute bids for you. Tell me your maximum bid and I will bid in approprite increments until your limit is reached. At no time will I increase your bid if you are currently the high bidder.
- Gross error in description is the only cause for a return. You must notify me in four days of receiptof your order if you intend to make any returns. As the buyer, you are responsible for all shipping costs on returned items, while making sure the items are in the same condition as when they were received.
- Winners will be notified by mail, and payment is due upon receipt of invoice. Layaways are not allowed. A minimum shipping fee of \$3 will be charged to those who have winning bids. Some items will require additional postage due to weight and/or value. Insurance is optional. All items will be shipped via US Priority Mail, unless otherwise specified on the bidding form.
- A bank certified check or a money order is the preferred form of payment, however a personal check is acceptable. Make all payment to: TIM JOHNSON
- The placing of a bid is an Agreement to Purchase, indicating that you agree to the Terms and Conditions. All items will be sold to the highest bidder. In case of a tie bid, the earliest bid received is the winner.

You may call anytime after 12 noon CST on Sunday, April 2 to find out if your bids in either session were successful. Please limit your inquiries to those lots in which you were an

# Friday, March 31, 2000 (6 PM to 2 AM CST)

- ALFRED E. NEUMAN BLACKLIGHT POSTER
   Produced in the late 1960s by AA Sales in Seattle, this poster features Alfred E. Neuman with the "What-Me Worry" caption. It measures 11" x 14", is in full color, and is in MINT condition.
- WILLIAM GAINES CHICAGO COMICON POSTER
   This poster was produced for an early 1980s Chicago Comicon appearance by MAD founder Bill Gaines. These posters were displayed in and around the hotel where the Comicon was held. It is in NM condition, is framed and is ready to hang.
- MAD RACING T-SHIRT
   This shirt was made to promote the MAD funny car, driven (at the time) by Jerry Toliver. It is an XL, is in full color, and is in mint condtion.
- 4. ALFRED E. NEUMAN CHOKING POSTER

  This poster is a MAD office premium from the early 1980s, which parodies the Heimlich manuever poster which was popular around that time. It measures "11 x "14 on heavy stock paper, and is in Mint condition.
- 5. ALFRED E. NEUMAN ON TOILET ARTWORK
  This item was done at the 1994 Chicago Comicon by an artist who specializes in taking your favorite comic character and draws them sitting on a toilet. The artwork measures approx.
  "11 x"14, is done is magic marker, and is framed and ready to hang. In Mint condition.
- ALFRED E. NEUMAN RUSSIAN NESTING DOLLS
   MB \$25
   These nesting dolls were made in 1998 by Russian immigrants living in Ohio. They feature Alfred in various poses from the covers of MAD. They are beautifully hand painted, and fit precisely within one another. In Mint condition.
- MAD AND ALFRED E. NEUMAN MARBLES
   These marbles were made in 1998. They are handpainted, and one features the MAD logo while the other features Alfred E. Neuman. In Mint condition.
- 8. ALFRED E. NEUMAN LARGE BUST
  This is an excellent example of the harder to find large Alfred E. Neuman bust. There are a few minor blemishes on the face and head, but there are no cracks or chips. The felt is a light green and there is no sticker. Overall condition is F/VF.
- ALFRED E. NEUMAN SNOWGLOBE
   This item was produced for sale in the Spencer Gifts novelty stores in 1998-9. It features Alfred E. Neuman, wearing his red and white striped shirt and red shorts, holding his umbrella. The base has "What-Me Worry" in raised lettering on the front. In Mint condition.
- 10. "CERTIFIED MAD" PRE-PRODUCTION COFFEE MUG

  This coffee mug was used in the production of the four different MAD coffee mugs that were made in 1996. It is white in color, and has no other graphics featured anywhere on the face of the mug. The bottom, however, features a "Certified MAD" logo, with the words "original color" printed beneath it, indicating that white was the original background color to be used. Mint.
- 11. ALFRED E. NEUMAN "MARS" SCULPTURE

  Sculpted by the creative hands of MAD collector Tom Anderson, this sculpture utilizes the head of an Alfred E. Neuman Warner Bros. statue. Tom used the Mars Lunar Landing as the idea for this piece. Apparently, there was a rumor that said one of the rock formations

photographed by the lunar module looked very much like the head of Alfred E. Neuman. Tom took this idea and created this wonderful piece. This piece is made with cement, red sand, and the base and head of an Alfred Warner Bros. statue. Includes a small replica space lunar module. In Mint condition.

#### 12. ALFRED E. NEUMAN NODDER

MB \$25

This piece was designed and created by the people who brought you the phony Alfred E. Neuman bust of the early 1990s. It is beautifully painted and glazed, and the nodder assembly works terrific. In mint condition.

#### 13. ALFRED E. NEUMAN CHRISTMAS ORNAMENT

MB \$5

This item was another Spencer Gifts item from 1996. It features Alfred E. Neuman in his classic "What-Me Worry" pose. The pose is exactly like the one used for the Alfred E. Neuman Warner Bros. statue. This item is in Mint condition, in an unopened box.

#### 14. SWEDISH MAD PEN

MB \$20

This item is one of many wonderful promotional items produced by the Swedish MAD. The pen is half silver and half black, and features the "Svenska MAD" logo on the side. Comes with its own plastic case, which also has the "Svenska MAD" logo on it. Both are in Mint condition.

#### 15. ALFRED E. NEUMAN GLASS TUMBLER

MB \$10

MB \$5

Produced in Australia in 1994, this glass features Alfred E. Neuman on one side and the MAD logo in red on the other. The glass has a frosted appearance. In Mint condition.

16. MAD STEIN

This stein was produced in 1996. It features alternating red and white Alfred E. Neuman faces along the side, and also has the classic "Alfred E. Neuman for President" pose on the end. In Mint condition.

#### 17. ALFRED E. NEUMAN DOLL

MB \$5

Here is another one of those Spencer Gifts items. This one is an Alfred E. Neuman doll. The doll has a rubber face with a cloth body and is in its original box, unopened. In mint condition.

#### 18. BRITISH MAD PROMOTIONAL POSTER

MB \$20

This poster was made for the British MAD, and was used from 1972 to 1979. Entitled, "Get MAD - Stay Sane", this poster is in full color, and is in VF/NM condition, the only flaw being that it is folded.

## 19. PRE-MAD ALFRED POSTCARD - HOTEL DESOTO

MB \$10

This pre-MAD postcard features Alfred E. Neuman in an advertisement for the Hotel Desoto. It has blue printing on white card stock, and is in Mint condition.

# 20. MAD STICKER BANNER

MB \$5

This paper banner was made for displays for the MAD Sticker set produced by Fleer in 1983. It is VF condition, the only flaw being that it is tri-folded.

#### 21. SPY VS. SPY COFFEE MUG

MB \$5

This mug was produced in 1996, and is one of four different MAD coffee mugs made that year. The mug features both the Black and White Spies sneering at each other. In Mint condition.

## 22. MAD CERAMIC MAGNETS - SET OF FOUR

MB \$5

This lot consists of four ceramic magnets that were produced in 1996 by the same company that made the coffee mugs and steins. The first magnet features Alfred for President; the second has the Mingo face with a MAD logo; the third has Alfred with "What-Me Worry" shaved on the back of his head, and the fourth has the Black and White Spies. All are in Mint condition.

## 23. "PRE-MAD??" DEBUTANTE BALL PROGRAM #1

MB \$20

This is not a pre-MAD item, since the pre-MAD era ended in 1956. However, this item uses an Alfred E. Neuman face on its cover. This is a pocket-size program from a debutantes ball held in Chicago in 1964. The cover has the only reference to Alfred E. Neuman; he is dressed as the King of Diamonds. A very unique piece, in NM condition.

#### 24. "BAD" TRADING CARD

MB \$2

This card was released in 1993 by Active Marketing International, as part of their "Defective Comics" card set. It features a parody of MAD #1, and is titled "Tales that are just plain BAD." It is in full color and in Mint condition.

# 25. ALFRED E. NEUMAN CERAMIC MAGNET

MB \$5

This magnet was modeled after the head of the Alfred E. Neuman bendy toy from 1988. It is beautifully painted and glazed and is in Mint condition.

# 26. MAD/LOST IN SPACE COFFEE MUG

MB \$10

This coffee mug features two panels from the MAD parody of Lost in Space entitled, "Loused Up In Space." The other half of the mug has a picture of the cast reacting to the MAD parody. In Mint condition.

#### 27. TOTALLY MAD REVIEWER'S GUIDE

MB \$50

This book was supposed to have been made for retailers who ordered the Totally MAD CD-ROM set, but due to the enormous amount of orders, it was discovered that there were not enough for everyone. Ultimately, these were never distributed. Instead, a few people who were involved in the production of the CD-ROM set were the lucky recipients. This reviewer's guide is full of information about the Totally MAD set. The book also includes some MAD factoids, a demo guide, and biographies of the "Usual Gang of Idiots." This spiral-bound book is full color throughout, and is in Mint condition

## 28. MAD DRY-ERASE BOARD

MB \$5

This item is a subscription premium from 1998. It is a dry-erase board and features a full color Alfred E. Neuman on the front. It is factory sealed and in Mint condition.

#### 29. SWEDISH MAD STICKERS

MB \$15

These stickers were produced for the Swedish MAD magazine in the 1970s. They are in full color and measure "2 x "3 for the smallest to "9 x "12 to the largest. All are in Mint condition.

# 30. ALFRED E. NEUMAN BELT BUCKLE

MB \$4

This belt buckle was produced in the mid-1970s. The front of the buckle has Alfred E. Neuman with the caption "What- Me Worry". It is used with some minor surface wear. In VF condition.

#### 31. MAD COFFEE MUG DISPLAY SIGN

MB \$10

This display sign was made for the MAD coffee mugs from 1996. It is made of heavy cardboard, and measures approx. "11 x "30. It is in full color, and features the Certified MAD logo. Overall condition is G/VG, with surface scratches and a slight crease mark.

#### 32. ALFRED E. NEUMAN 45 RPM RECORD W/PICTURE SLEEVE

MB \$75

This record was released in 1959 by ABC-Paramount. The picture sleeve is what makes this item desirable. The sleeve features a Mingo rear-view portrait of Alfred, along with drawings by Don Martin. Overall condition is F/VF, with two pen markings on one side of the sleeve which are partially obscured by the Don Martin artwork.

#### 33. MAD SUBWAY POSTER

MB \$50

This poster was displayed in the New York City subways during the 1988 Presidential campaign. It measures "30 x "45, and is VF/NM condition, with masking tape residue on the lower corners. It has been dry-mounted on foam-core for easy displayability.

#### 34. MAD SKATEBOARD - SMALL

MB \$25

This lot features the smaller size version of the Nash MAD skateboard from the late 1980s.

Overall condition is VF/NM, with minor surface scratches on the bottom of the board and wheels.

# 35. OVERSIZE PRE-MAD ALFRED E. NEUMAN MATCHBOOK

MB \$10

This matchbook is from Bob Adamcik's cafe in Schulenberg, Texas. Overall condition is F/VF, with surface wear and a rusty staple. About 75% of the matches are still attached.

#### 36. ALFRED E. NEUMAN DISGUISE KIT

MB \$5

This disguise kit is from the late 1980s. In Mint condition, it even has the original K-Mart price sticker attached.

#### 37. MAD NAPKINS / PLAYING CARDS LOT

MB \$10

This lot consists of a box of MAD napkins and a sealed, two-deck box of MAD playing cards, each sold in the Warner Bros. stores in 1993-4. Both are in Mint condition.

#### 38. MAD MATCHES W/ CASE

MB \$10

This lot consists of a set of twelve humorous matchbooks with a plastic storage case. Probably produced in the 1960s, these matches were made with the attempt to cash in on MAD's popularity at the time, as evidenced by the similar-looking MAD logo on the box. Overall condition is VF.

#### 39. MAD PINBALL CLOTH PATCH

MB \$20

This cloth patch was made to promote the MAD pinball machine, which ended up never being produced due to copyright technicalities. It features an embroidered Alfred E. Neuman with the words "What - Me Worry" above his head, and "MAD Pinball" beneath. It is in full color and is in Mint condition.

#### 40. MAD LOGO PIN

MB \$50

This pin is made from 14K gold and was modeled after an original MAD staff pin. It is the exact size and shape of the original and is in Mint condition.

## 41. ALFRED E. NEUMAN BRITISH PINBACK BUTTON

MB \$5

This pinback button was offered as a subscription premium for the British MAD magazine in the early 1980s. It is in full color and is in Mint condition.

## 42. ALFRED E. NEUMAN SILVER COIN

MB \$10

This silver coin was produced in the late 1980s and is an unlicensed item. In Mint condition.

#### 43. ALFRED E. NEUMAN ZIPPO LIGHTER

MB \$5

This lighter was made in the 1970s, and it shows. Suffering from surface wear, scratches and paint chipping, the lighter looks as if it has gone through a war. The Alfred face on the side is still legible, as well as the "Who-Me Worry" caption beneath. Overall condition is Good, as it is missing the cover also.

#### 44. MAD FUNNY CAR 1:64 SCALE CAR

**MB \$5** 

This "Hot-Wheels"-type toy car was made in 1998. It is a 1:64 scale version of the MAD Funny Car that was driven by Jerry Toliver. It is factory sealed and is in Mint condition/

#### 45. 1964 / 1968 ALFRED E. NEUMAN FOR PRESIDENT BUTTON

MB \$15

This button was found in the 1964 and 1968 Alfred E. Neuman for President campaign kits that were ordered through MAD magazine. It is in full color, and is in VG condition, with slight rusting on the back.

#### 46. ALFRED E.NEUMAN MAGNET

MB \$5

This magnet is an unlicensed item from 1998. It is in full color and features Alfred E. Neuman on

the front, with the "What - Me Worry" caption underneath. The apperance of this magnet is similar to that of a pinback button. In Mint condition.

# 47. NORWEGIAN MAD PINBACK BUTTONS SET

MB \$10

This set of two buttons is part of a subscrition premium from the Norwegian MAD magazine. The first button is in full color and features Alfred with the words "Hullu - Mutta Ongelmaton". The second button is in black and white and has the word "OTYA!" printed over Alfred's eyes. Both pinbacks are in Mint condition.

## 48. ALFRED E. NEUMAN BELT BUCKLE

MB \$5

This belt buckle was made using a bronze Alfred E. Neuman coin. In Mint condition.

# 49. MADTV EMMY CONSIDERATION VIDEOTAPE

MB \$10

This videotape was given out to the 1998 Emmy voters. The tape has one episode of MAD-TV on it (Feb. 28, 1998), and is in sealed Mint condition.

## 50. UP THE ACADEMY PINBACK BUTTON - LARGE

MB \$10

This pinback button was given out to theaters as a promotional item for the movie, :"Up the Academy". It is red, white and blue, and features Alfred on the front. In NM condition.

#### 51. SPY VS SPY ATF CLOTH PATCH

MB \$10

This Tactical Operations Officer's patch features an unlicensed use of the Black Spy by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms. It is in full color and is in Mint condition.

#### 52. PRE-MAD ALFRED E. NEUMAN PORTRAIT

MB \$15

This lot consists of a "11 x "14 portrait of Alfred E. Neuman with the caption, "Sure I'm For The New Deal". It suffers from water staining, but the staining gives it some character. Overall condition is Good. Comes framed and ready to hang.

#### 53. ALFRED E. NEUMAN POSTERS LOT

MB \$10

This lot consists of two different Alfred E. Neuman posters. Produced in 1992 by OSP, these posters measure "24 x "36 and are in Mint condition.

#### 54. MAD #7 SIGNED PRINT

MB \$25

This lot consists of a "16 x "24 print of MAD #7, which has been signed and numbered by Harvey Kurtzman. It is in Mint condition, and is framed and ready to hang.

#### 55. SPY VS SPY ORIGINAL ARTWORK

MB \$300

This is the original artwork to a Spy vs. Spy piece from MAD #92. It is in Mint condition, and is signed by Antoinio Prohias in the lower right hand corner. It has been matted and framed, and is ready to hang.

## 56. ALFRED E. NEUMAN MARDI GRAS COSTUME

MB \$750

This lot consists of one of the rarest MAD collectibles ever made, the Alfred E. Neuman Mardi Gras costume. The overall condition of this piece is VG/F, with a couple of tears in the bottom fabric and a small crack at the top of the mask. The mask also suffers from minor paint scratches and rubbing. The costume itself is still a solid piece and is in no danger of falling apart, unlike a few others which have been auctioned off in the past.

#### 57. UP THE ACADEMY PRINTERS PROOF

MB \$10

This lots consists of a black on gold printers proof of the Up the Academy movie poster. It measures "17 x "22 and is in NM condition.

# 58. SERGIO ARAGONES ORIGINAL MAD ARTWORK

MB \$125

This lot consists of the original artwork for the piece entitled "Before The Concert", from MAD #200. The artwork measures "14 x "18, and is in NM condition. Framed and ready to hang.

- 59. MAD PANIC #13 ORIGINAL COVER ARTWORK

  This lots consists of the original cover artwork for the MAD Panic #13, by artist Cecil Sutton.

  The artwork measures "9 x "12 and is Mint condition. Framed and ready to hang.
- 60. MAD ABOUT THE MOVIES WARNER BROS. PRINT

  This lot consists of a print from the Warner Bros. Studio Store entitled, "MAD About the Movies".

  It is signed and numbered by the artist, Mort Drucker. Beautifully framed and matted. In Mint cond.
- 61. MAD T-SHIRTS LOT #1

  This lot consists of three t-shirts from the mid-1990s. All are size XL, and only one has been worn; the black "Parental Advisory" t-shirt. Condition of this shirt is F/VF, while the other two are Mint and unwashed. Of special note, the Alfred with the umbrella shirt was a prototype shirt and was never sold.
- 62. MAD / STANLEY DESANTIS T-SHIRT

  This shirt is one of the hardest shirts to find from the Stanley DeSantis line. It is powder blue with printed clouds, and features a full color Alfred E. Neuman on the front with the words,

  "It's a MAD MAD MAD MAD World" underneath. It has been worn, but is in NM condition. Size XL.
- 63. MAD T-SHIRTS LOT #2

  This lot consists of three child-size t-shirts from the late 1980s. All three have been worn and washed, but are still in great condition. Individual colors are pink, white, and light blue/green.
- 64. MAD / ALFRED E. NEUMAN COLLAGE

  This collage was made using what appears to be paperback book covers, newpaper clippings, money from the MAD game, MAD trading cards, and a Golden Trashery of MAD dustjacket. The pieces of the collage have been attached to a framed cork board, then laquered heavily. Measuring "24 x "36, this is a unique and colorful work of art.
- 65. CERTIFIED MAD DENIM HAT This denim hat was sold in the Spencer Gifts stores in 1998-9. It is unused and in Mint condition.
- 66. ALFRED E. NEUMAN CERAMIC PLATE

  This Alfred E. Neuman ceramic plate was offered for sale through the Franklin Mint in 1996. It is a full color reproduction of the cover of MAD #218, and measures approx. "7 x "9. Comes with a Certificate of Authenticity from the Franklin Mint. In Mint condition.
- 67. MAD FUNNY CAR MODEL KIT

  This is the model kit by Revell for the MAD Funny Car. It is still sealed and in Mint condition.
- 68. ALFRED E. NEUMAN SALT AND PEPPER SHAKERS MB \$30 This lot consists of a set of Alfred E. Neuman salt and pepper shakers. These unlicensed items are made from the fake Alfred E. Neuman bust and the bases are glazed black for pepper and gray for salt. Although these items are Mint and unused, it is assumed that the spices come out of the eyes and nostrils.
- 69. SONS OF CHAMPLIN CONCERT POSTER

  This poster was made for the Sons of Champlin concert in Denver in 1967. Measuring "13 x "22, it is in Mint condition. It is also framed and ready to hang.
- 70. GERMAN MAD "MAD MULL" LOT #1

  This lot consists of four different copies of the German MAD MULL paperback book. These books are actually issues of German MAD which have been bound together to complete a magazine-size paperback book. This lot contains issues 7, 9, 12, and 13. In VF/NM condition.

# 71. CERTIFIABLY MAD PAPERBACK BOXED SETS LOT

MB \$50

This lot consists of four different Certifiably MAD paperback boxed sets. They are different because of the color variations of the boxes. These different colors include gold, blue, green, and orange. Also different are the books that are in each boxed set.

Overall condition of these boxed sets is VG/F, with the books averaging NM/M. The boxes have corner, surface, and edge wear but are quite colorful with no fading.

# 72. ALFRED E. NEUMAN SLOT MACHINE

MB \$200

This is a never-before-seen variation of an Alfred E. Neuman slot machine. It is a Sega machine, and dates back to the 1960s. It is "programmed" to take British pence and has not been converted to American coins. The machine is not in working order, but does light up when it is plugged in. Overall condition of the machine is VG, with scratches and surface pitting in the silverplate. The machine is an excellent restoration candidate, and a bargain at the minimum bid. Special shipping arrangements will be made with the winning bidder, as the machine is quite heavy. Shipping by truck will be the most logical way to ship this item.

# 73. PRE-MAD ALFRED E. NEUMAN CALENDAR

MB \$50

This pre-MAD calendar is an advertising calendar for the Percy Agency in Baton Rouge. It dates from 1943 and the overall condition is F/VF, with slight rusting on the staples. This is an excellent piece of rare pre-MAD memorabilia.

## 74. PRE-MAD PHOTOS LOT #1

MB \$5

This lot consists of two pre-MAD photos of Alfred E. Neuman. They are identical except for the caption underneath the face. The first photo has the caption, "Just Learned About the Birds and the Bees" and the other photo has the caption, "What - Me Worry". They are printed on heavy card stock and are in NM condition.

#### 75. MAD T-SHIRTS LOT #4

MB \$20

This lot consists of four t-shirts from the mid-1990s. All of the shirts are unwashed and are in Mint condition. Of special significance is the hard-to-find Alfred as Santa Claus t-shirt. All are XL.

#### 76. MAD T-SHIRTS LOT #5

MB \$10

This lot consists of three t-shirts from the mid-1990s. All of the shirts are unwashed and are in Mint condition. The two Spy vs Spy shirts even have the Certifiably MAD store tag still attached. The rare shirt in this lot, though, is the MAD TV t-shirt. The back of this shirt shows a partially shaved head of Alfred with the words, "MAD TV" shaved into his hair.

#### 77. MAD GREETING CARD HEADER SIGN

MB \$10

This lot consists of a greeting card rack header sign for the MAD line of greeting cards by Gibson greetings. This sign was placed on the rack and the different MAD cards were placed in front of it. It is printed on heavy stock and is in NM condition.

# 78. MAD CHECKS WITH CHECKBOOK COVER

MB \$10

Produced by Liberty check printers in 1996, these checks feature scenes from MAD. There are six different designs for the checks, and this lot contains only one of each design (6 checks total). Neuman dog face with the caption, "What - Me Furry?" The shirt is a size XL and is in Mint condition with the original store tag and sticker.

# 102. ALFRED E. NEUMAN "ORIGINAL" T-SHIRTS LOT

This lot consists of two different styles of the Alfred E. Neuman "Original" t-shirt made by Kedsco in 1981. They are both identical, except one has long sleeves and the other has no sleeves. They have both been worn and washed, and are in VG condition.

  This is the Spy vs. Spy Nintendo game by Kemco. Overall condition of the game and box is Fine.
- 123. MAD PANIC #19 ORIGINAL COVER ARTWORK

  This is the original cover artwork to issue #19 of the MAD Panic, by artist Cecil Sutton. It measures "10 x "15 and is in Mint condition. Framed and ready to hang.
- 124.ALFRED E. NEUMAN MATCHBOOKS LOT

  This lot consists of two matchbooks featuring Alfred E. Neuman. The first is a matchbook from The Mason Jar restaurant, a small chain in Texas. It is in Mint condition. The second is a matchbook from the Little Jack Horner joke and magic shop. It is in VG/F condition.

  This copy of the MAD Show record album is in VF condition. The record is NM.
